A program to encourage women lawyers to consider judicial careers, as well as make the process of appointment and election to the bench more transparent and accessible.

NAWJ is also at the forefront of combatting human trafficking, interrupting the school to prison pipeline, domestic violence, and supporting programs assisting women in prison.
