

From Ecosystem Vulnerabilities to Bad Actors: Understanding AI-Driven Risks in Modern Courts



The evolution of AI is rapidly progressing beyond assistants and copilots towards autonomous agents, and ultimately, interconnected ecosystems of specialized agents operating without direct human intervention. The courts lag behind in understanding AI, risk avoidance, safeguarding privacy and confidential information, and regulatory compliance. Across the world, government restrictions vary widely, and judges presiding over criminal and civil cross-border cases face new challenges. Judicial systems that lack knowledge, experience, and good policies are uniquely prone to risk, both within their borders and by international bad actors.

This session will explore these evolving risks from a judicial perspective, focusing on key areas including ecosystem risks, user reliance and trust, liability, security, privacy, accountability, and other aspects.

Earlier projects include Ukraine Siren Alerts, an

emergency notification system used by 15,000+ people during the war and later adopted by Ukrainian authorities, and PTOLEMI, an AI cancer-detection system published in the Journal of Diagnostics. He builds and ships AI-native products daily and recently delivered AI sessions for AllianceBernstein and FIT.
