The Honorable Brandy K. Mueller was first elected to the bench in November of 2010. The trial court she presides over is characterized by its high volume of cases. Her court also has a specialized docket for the youngest defendants in their adult criminal justice system (ages 17, 18 and 19). This specialized docket is designed to reduce the number of convictions and jail sentences for teenage defendants while providing an intensive term of probation that emphasizes work, school, and giving back to the community. It also calls for regular judicial oversight and swift consequences for non-compliance.

Judge Mueller is a native Texan. Before becoming a Judge, she worked in Austin as a lawyer for close to fifteen years, dedicating her career exclusively to the area of criminal law. She is both a former prosecutor and defense attorney who has practiced law at every level of trial court in our criminal justice system: County, State, District and Federal Court. She has served as an Assistant County Attorney, an Assistant District Attorney and at the United States Attorney's Office, as a Special Assistant United States Attorney. She has also represented numerous children in neglect and abuse cases as well as, Defendants in criminal cases. She is licensed in both State and Federal Court and has played an active role in our community, having served on the Boards of the Austin Bar Association, the Austin State Supported Living Center, and Back on My Feet, the Dispute Resolution Center, CAN Academy and the Lola Wright Foundation. She is a graduate of Leadership Austin and former Barrister in the Robert Calvert Inn of Court.
