After graduating from DePaul University College of Law, she began her legal career clerking for Illinois Appellate Court Justice William Cousins Jr. and Illinois Supreme Court Justice Charles Freeman. Her dedication to public service was further exemplified in her role as Associate General Counsel for the Chicago Housing Authority, where she spent 14 years navigating Contracts, Torts, and Housing Policy and Legislation Divisions. She then served as a Principal Attorney with the Metropolitan Water Reclamation District, focusing on employment, real estate, and environmental law.

Before law school, Judge Saindon was a mental health specialist, counseling court-referred adolescents and adults, and giving vital presentations on teen mental health and suicide prevention. Her career has now come full circle with her appointment in March 2023 as Associate Judge of Cook County, where she sits in the Child Protection Division, continuing her lifelong dedication to the well-being of children and adolescents.

Judge Saindon is an advocate for social justice and education.
