Judge Ann Barnes, Georgia Court of Appeals

In April, Judge Barnes and her colleagues hosted an open appellate court proceeding, attended by 700 high school students at RiverCenter for the Performing Arts in Columbus, Georgia, to promote public access and illuminate the Court of Appeals' business beyond its traditional gallery of

courthouse spectators in Atlanta. In her interview with WRBL Channel 3 News, Judge Barnes stated that "she wanted them to see that an appeal is not just an abstract
