Brenda P. Murray earned a law degree from Boston University School of Law and an MBA from the Robert H. Smith School of Business at the University of Maryland. Murray was an administrative law judge with three federal agencies, including over twenty years as Chief Administrative Law Judge, Securities and Exchange Commission. Murray is a former President of the National Association of Women Judges and Chair of the American Bar Association's Division of Government and Public Sector Lawyers, which she helped organize. Murray headed a volunteer effort that initiated a college degree program at the Maryland Correctional Institution for Women, and headed NAWJ's Women in Prison Committee when it, along with others, stopped closure of the only federal women's prison in New England. Murray was an honoree in L'Oreal Paris's Women of Worth program and was named to the Enforcement Hall of Fame by Securities Docket, an industry organization.
