

## **Hon. Sharon E. Goodie**

Sharon E. Goodie is an Administrative Law Judge for the District of Columbia Office of Administrative Hearings. She was appointed in 2005. She hears matters involving public benefits, homeless shelter, nursing home, and mental health group home issues. She has previously heard cases involving licensing, property violations, rental housing, taxicab complaints, public school discipline, and unemployment compensation.

Judge Goodie is a Program Director and Team Leader for the National Institute of Trial Advocacy, where she teaches Trial Skills programs for practicing attorneys, and specialized public service Trial Skills programs for legal aid attorneys. She is also a Commissioner on the District of Columbia Access to Justice Commission and a Judicial Director of the District of Columbia Council for Court Excellence.

Judge Goodie previously worked for the District of Columbia Office of the Attorney General, where she handled juvenile delinquency, child abuse, and civil neglect cases. She has also worked at private litigation firms handling insurance coverage, medical malpractice, telecommunications, and corporate compliance matters.

Judge Goodie received her Bachelor of Arts degree, cum laude, from Brandeis University, and she received her Juris Doctor degree from the Georgetown University Law Center. She previously clerked for the Honorable Harriett R. Taylor at the Superior Court.
