

Judge Lisa Walsh has been a trial and appellate judge Miami, Florida for 15 years. She is also an adjunct professor of appellate advocacy at St. Thomas Law School. She serves as International Director for the National Association of Women Judges (NAWJ) and Director for the International Association of Women Judges (IAWJ). She was the 2015-2016 President of NAWJ.

In 2016, she passed a national resolution calling on all judges to "make appointments that are consistent with the diversity of our society and

the justice system." She leads the US efforts to support refugees who were women judges in Afghanistan.
