

Hon. Paul B. Handy is a Principal Administrative Law Judge with the D.C. Office of Administrative Hearings, currently coordinating hearings in unemployment insurance cases. Judge Handy has also served as co-Coordinator of Training, and PALJ for Public Benefits and Licensing and Enforcement cases.
