She currently serves as the Justice liaison to data gathering and transparency work and the Michigan Judicial Institute. She is a co-chair of the Diversity Equity & Inclusion Commission, co-chairs the Justice for All Commission's Data Workgroup, and serves on the Justice for All Commission's Resource and Communications Workgroups.
