

Tarina Mand's legal career is driven by purpose, advocacy, and impact. A skilled complex litigation attorney, she's equally known for advancing diversity, equity, and inclusion in the legal field. As past president of the South Asian Bar Association (SABA) San Diego and Chair of the Racial Justice Taskforce for SABA North America, she launched the Equal Pay Transparency Initiative which sought to bridge the gender and minority pay gap, and she testified before the California Assembly in support of Senate Bill 403 which sought to make California the first state to ban caste discrimination.
