



Annette Boyd Pitts is Director of the Justice Teaching Center, an academic center on the campus of Florida Southern College. Pitts designs and administers research-based civic and law-related education programs and curriculum as well as high impact professional development models. She is a veteran civic literacy and law-related education specialist, international trainer and education policy consultant, and civic learning entrepreneur. Pitts also serves as National Education Chair with the Judicial Independence Committee of the National Association of Women Judges. She has worked with the Committee and its corresponding Informed Voters, Fair Judges Project since 2012.

Pitts is the recipient of the Sandra Day O'Connor National Advancements in Civic Education Award, presented by Justice O'Connor during the annual conference of the National Center for State Courts. She has also received the National Improvements in Justice Award and the American Bar Association Isidore Starr Award for Excellence in Law Education. In 2019, Pitts received the Excellence in Service Award from the National Association of Women Judges for her work nationally in judicial independence and public education.

Throughout her career, Pitts has worked in over 25 countries to advance education for democracy and has administered trilateral international education partnerships in Eastern/Central Europe and Latin America. She has authored a wide range of adult, secondary, and post-secondary civic literacy and law-related education curricular materials and has created, scripted, and published civic learning courses, animations, and online resources. Pitts has served on multiple state education policy committees to create civics and government grade-level content standards and assessments as well as testified before legislative committees on civic education best practices and the characteristics of high and low-performing school districts.

Pitts has dedicated decades of her career to educating the public about the courts and the judicial branch. She has authored and published numerous articles in professional journals including *Social Education*, *The Federal Lawyer*, *Voir Dire*, *International Journal of Social Education*, *The Florida Bar Journal*, and other publications. Pitts holds advanced degrees and higher education certifications from Florida State University College of Education, Harvard University Bok Center for Teaching and Learning, and other institutions.
