Rebecca Curtiss is currently Senior Staff Attorney on the Tucson Children’s Team of the Florence Immigrant and Refugee Rights Project, the legal service provider for all detained immigrant children and adults in Arizona. She has been representing unaccompanied children in removal proceedings and in their applications for immigration relief since 2016. Additionally, she serves as co-chair of the Southern Arizona Transnational Families Task Force, a group dedicated to addressing issues faced by families in dependencies who are impacted by immigration laws or the US border. Rebecca spent 6 years representing parents and children in dependency matters and served as guardian ad litem for child victims of misdemeanor domestic violence charges. Before law school, Rebecca worked for approximately 5 years as a lay legal advocate assisting victims of domestic violence with criminal, family, and immigration matters.
