The Danger is Real



Attacks on Judges are up across the board

- 400% for federal judges
- Similar numbers for state judges



The types of threats have changed

- Personal grievances still exist and continue
- Threats that target future behavior are up significantly



Women and women of color are at a higher risk

- Female judges face a 40% higher threat risk
- Threats are more insidious and more violent

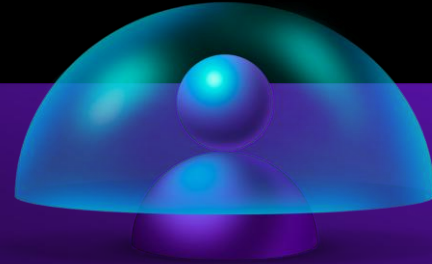

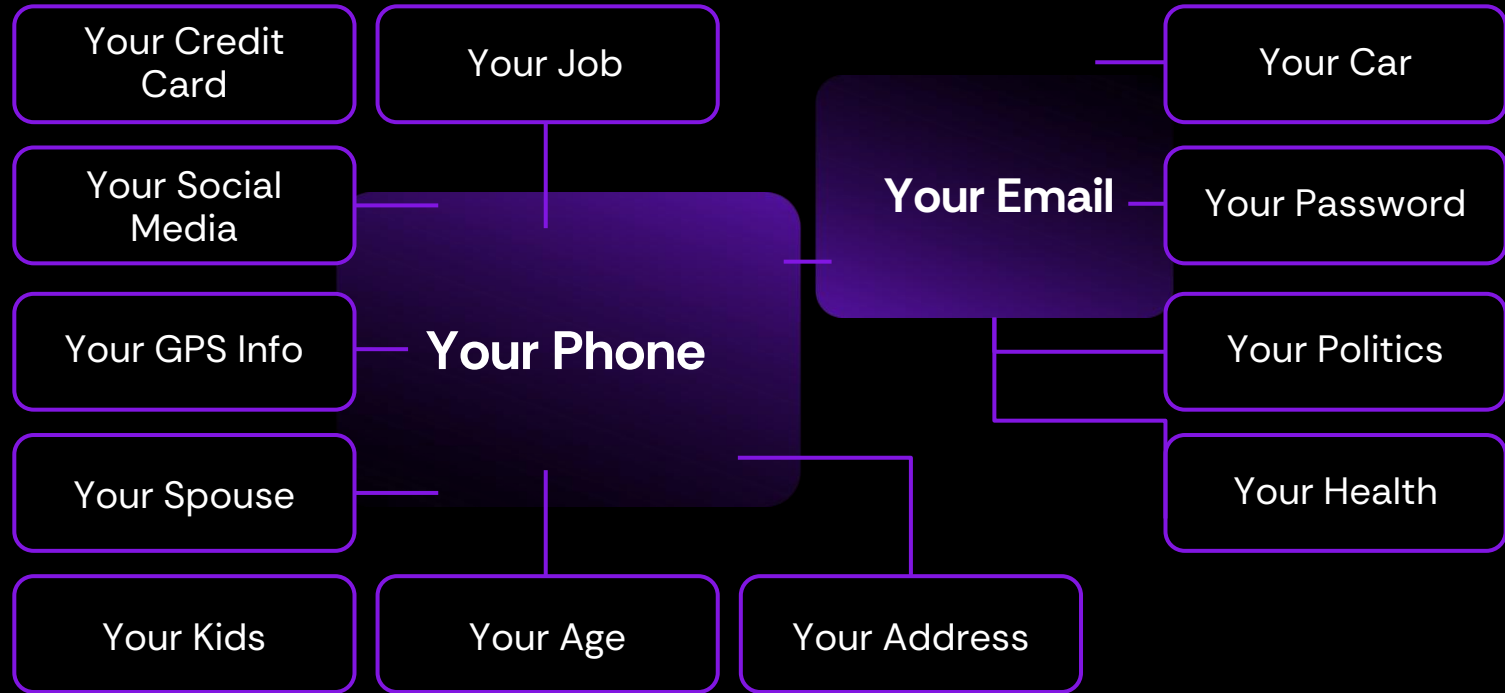

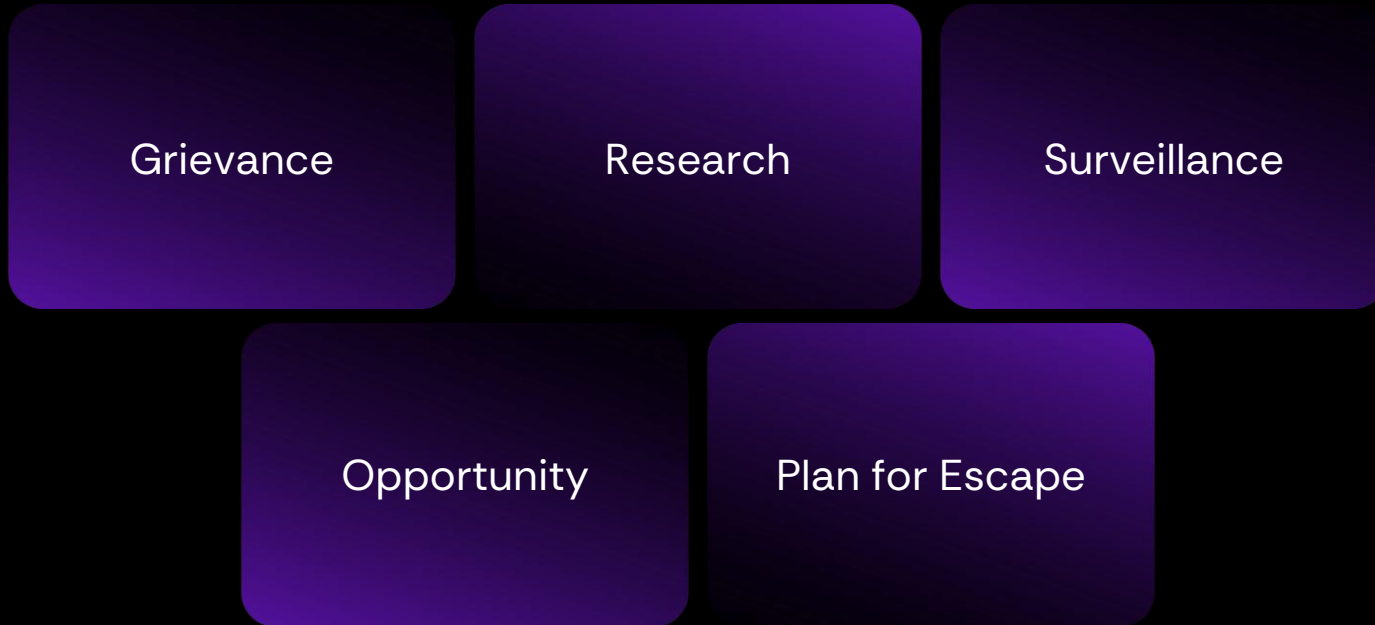
