FIND LEGAL ASSISTANCE

Fresh Start

- Offers FREE comprehensive criminal record relief and help with reducing convictions
- Gives guidance in obtaining Certificates of Rehabilitation

PACC Team / Homeless Court

- Provides overview of outstanding traffic tickets, fines, and fees that may be barriers upon release

Family Law Facilitators

- Provides family law assistance to parties without attorneys, and offers help with court forms and general legal information

Legal Aid

- Provides low-income clients with free civil legal advice and counsel, effective referrals, and legal representation
- Offers free help with CalWORKS, CalFresh, child custody and visitation, and social security income

START YOUR CAREER

Kitchens for Good

- Provides tuition-free 12-week certified culinary apprenticeship program
- Provides technical skills, workforce readiness instruction, case management and industry certification

San Diego Workforce Partnership

- Funds job training programs that empower job seekers to meet the current and future workforce needs of employers in San Diego County

FAMILY, FOOD & HOUSING

Child Support Services

- Establishes paternity, obtains and enforces support orders, and may assist with order modification and Debt Reduction Program
- Enhances the lives and well-being of children and promotes family self-sufficiency by establishing and enforcing court orders

Health & Human Services Agency

- Provides food assistance, childcare, cash aid, CalFresh and special programs for refugees and human trafficking victims
- Provides child welfare services

HEALTH SERVICES

Ending the Game Program

- Provides support to human trafficking victims and those affected by the sex industry. This program is aimed at reducing the rate of recidivism among sex trafficking survivors

Alabaster Jar Project

- Provides housing and resources for women who have survived human trafficking and sexual exploitation

La Maestra

- Provides primary care and specialty services (behavior and mental health, chronic disease management) to culturally diverse and lowest income communities

GET ADVANCED EDUCATION

Grossmont College

- Pathways to Success Academy: provides college credits, tutoring and financial aid info to inmates who succeed in the program

San Diego State University – Project Rebound

- A special admissions and support program for students transitioning out of prison
- Committed to improving student success, advancing research and creative endeavors, and building a culture of philanthropy

Southwestern College – Restorative Justice Program

- Provides individuals impacted by the justice system with help along their education journey
