Research Data and Legal Developments in Artificial Intelligence

What does research data indicate about the use of artificial intelligence, and how will it affect the work of judges? This educational program will examine research data from multiple studies about the use of AI in the legal profession, including research underwritten by Relativity. Together with an examination of recent case law, which will provide guidance from around the nation and the world on how judges have ruled on AI, this program will provide insight into what judges can expect to see in their courts, including whether more plaintiff or defense lawyers use AI, whether larger or smaller firms use AI, what concerns legal teams about AI, the implications for access to justice, and more.
